Questions

Q: Tents: can we pitch tents up at the marae?

A: The marae has replied - No tents.

Q: The pub will be closed on Christmas Day - is there a venue for alcohol?

A: No. Everything will be closed. Unless a whanau member nearby offers (no one has by the way), there is no facility to drink on Christmas Day. The Colonial (a pub) up the road from the marae will operate as per usual. Note: the marae is smoke, drug and alcohol free (there is a designated cigarette smoking area).

Q: Some whanau need to use sleeping aides (eg: respiratory machines, pillows, blankets etc) - PLEASE bring these with you as it will be a busy time and having a good nights sleep will be recommended. Also bring all medications etc for the duration. Don't forget to notify the committee (if you have not already done so), if you have special dietary needs or allergies to certain foods.
